



ORDER


1. **WHEREAS** Shri Bijender Kumar & others, Electrician-cum-Plumbers working in different JNVs under the administrative jurisdiction of the NVS Regional Offices across the country filed an OA no. 444/2025 before the Hon'ble CAT Principal Bench, at New Delhi praying for direction to the respondents to constitute a Committee of Technical Officer with the representative of the applicants to consider grievances regarding cadre restructuring, amendment of Recruitment Rules by separating the post of Electrician-cum-Plumber, fixing working hours and creating post of Helper / Khalassi in each school to help the ECPs while performing duties. They further prayed to pass an order directing to the respondents to fix the duty hours and pay overtime allowances for taking duties allegedly beyond duty hours. The aforesaid OA has been finally disposed of by means of judgment and order dated 17.02.2026. The operative portion of the judgment is extracted below: -

"7. Considered the rival contentions, perused the pleadings and examined all the judgments that are relied upon by the parties. In view of the facts discussed above, we are of the considered opinion that in view of the onerous, cumbersome and tedious nature of the job of Electrician-cum-Plumber (ECP) which is a 12 to 16 hours of job every day beginning from 6 AM and finishing at 10 PM, the ECP deserves to get a helper to give him/her more ease and convenience while discharging the duties efficiently and effectively. We have noted that the respondents in their counter affidavit have mentioned that RRs have been changed earlier and that the Helper too can be hired (by outsourcing). Also as per Apex Court Judgment Recruitment Rules (RRs) should be revised every 5 years so that they are in sync with changing times and remain contemporary to prevent stagnation, and keep the staff sufficiently motivated.

8. In the light of the above, we are of the considered opinion that the ends of justice would be met if this case is remanded to respondent no. 2 (Commissioner-NVS) treating this OA as a representation with a direction to do the 'due diligence' and pass an appropriate, reasoned and speaking order within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. We make it clear that we are in no way indulging in judicial activism and over-reach; that we are not encroaching on the policy making domain of the executive under the Doctrine of Separation of Powers/Checks and Balances but only trying to mitigate the occupational hardship of the poor and helpless Electricians-cum-Plumbers (ECPs) of Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas (JNVs) of Navodaya Vidyalaya Samity (NVS). Therefore, the instant OA is disposed of in the aforesaid terms. MAs if any are also disposed of in similar fashion. However, there will be no order as to costs."

2. AND WHEREAS in compliance with the order dated 17.02.2026 passed by the Hon'ble CAT Principal Bench, New Delhi, the various grievances and contentions raised in the Original Application (treating as representation) have been carefully examined in the light of the records of the case by the Competent Authority. The applicants in the said OA have mainly prayed for the following grievances which are summarized herein below:


- The post of Electrician-cum-Plumber is non-existent anywhere else in Government departments/institutions in India; Electrician and Plumber are two distinct trades with different duties, qualifications, and skill levels, yet a single person is forced to perform both roles in JNVs.
- Each JNV is a large residential campus (with hostels, staff quarters, school buildings, etc.) requiring round-the-clock maintenance of electrical and plumbing systems, but there is only one Electrician-cum-Plumber with **no Helper/Khallasi** provided, making the workload unmanageable.
- Applicants work more than **16 hours daily, 7 days a week**, without holidays, overtime allowance, or weekly off, starting as early as 6 AM and remaining on call till late night, which violates the Government of India's 8-hour workday norm (OM dated 07.11.1986), Factories Act, and Minimum Wages Act.
- In other Government organizations, separate Electrician (Highly Skilled) and Plumber (Skilled) posts exist with standard 48-hour



weekly duty, risk allowances, and other benefits; the combined post deprives applicants of these entitlements and benefits available to Electricians.

- Despite multiple representations by the applicants and the Navodaya Vidyalaya Employees Welfare Association (including in 2021), the organization have failed to consider cadre restructuring, separation of Electrician & Plumber posts, creation of Helper posts, or fixation of proper duty hours, rendering their action illegal, arbitrary, and discriminatory.


3. AND WHEREAS the aforesaid main grievances of the applicants have been considered by the competent authority in the light of the Recruitment Rules, various circulars / orders with regard to appointment of ECPs and discharging duties by them in the residential JNV schools and the competent authority observed that according to Indian service jurisprudence and Supreme Court rulings, cadre structuring is considered an executive policy matter. Creation, abolition, merger or restructuring of posts lies within the executive domain. An employee has a right to be considered for promotion but no fundamental right to demand creation of post or restructuring of the cadre accrues to an employee. **The NVS got created a post of ECP to meet the existing requirement pertaining to job of Electricity and Plumbing in the JNV campus and existing staffing pattern is sufficient to meet the administrative requirement.** ECPs have no feeder promotional avenues but simultaneously they have been provided with financial upgradation to address stagnation as per Govt. of India scheme of MACP in which three financial upgradation after 10, 20 and 30 years of regular service in the post is given during the entire service career subject to other fulfilment of essential conditions and suitability. The major works pertaining to electricity and plumbing are arranged by JNVs from outside under maintenance and repair funds annually. Construction agency too, carry out the major repair works under proper estimation as per rules & norms as and when required in the school buildings. The duties & responsibilities attached to the post of ECPs according to circular dated 29.04.1991 is for maintenance work of electrical installation as well as plumbing job and to attend faults, if any, in water supply and electrical systems. Chances are rare that electric faults occur in all places at a time and Electricians' work is to maintain the electric supply through the electrical lining and wirings which is already installed by the construction agency. In every JNV, there are pipelines for water supply and electricians' work is to ensure that water is being supplied as per schedule. Repair the leakage and other such minor repairing work does not require much labour and



technicality. Therefore, keeping in view the functional requirement, the ECPs are not required to attend like 8 hours regular window duty rather their duties are confined and scattered in a way to attend to the electrical and plumbing faults as and when needed. To ease any kind of burden, NVS vide guidelines dated 19.01.2012 specifically provided that for the purpose of job of plumbing, plumber may be engaged on contract basis under Annul M & R / contingencies budget. Further NVS vide letter dated 19.04.2022 issued directions for utilizing services of ECPs for conducting academic activities in JNVs and providing basic amenities and timely maintenance of electrical and water facilities in JNVs. The circular *inter-alia* provides that in case of any help to carry out duties of ECPs and handling equipment like ladder etc., additional help on the request of ECP is permitted from existing outsource manpower. Thus, the occupational hardship of the ECP, if any, has always been given due consideration by the cadre controlling authorities as per the available resources, existing norms & policy. All sorts of assistance and help shall be extended to them in discharge of official duties within the existing available manpower wherever required subject to satisfaction of the authorities concerned of necessitating such assistance. Thus, keeping in view the functional requirement at each unit (JNV residential campus), the ECPs are not burdened and do not require to perform duties beyond 8 hours a day cumulatively. ECPs have been compensated with weekly off for the duties performed on the weekends / public holidays.

The applicants are made aware of the facts that creation of separate posts, determination of cadre strength, restructuring cadres, prescribing qualification for a post, is exclusively within the powers & domain of the executive as held by the Hon'ble Supreme Court [*Indu Singh vs. Vyas Mani Mishra (1987), 3 SCC 25, Union of India vs. Pushpa Rani 2008 (9) SCC 24, Maharashtra State Road Transport Corporation vs. Casterive Rajya Parivahan Karmachari Sangathan (2009) 8 SCC 556*]. Thus employees cannot claim any of it as a matter of right and the same is exclusively to be decided by the organization concerned, seeing its functional and other administrative requirement.


4. **NOW THEREFORE**, for the foregoing facts & discussions, the grievances raised in the Original Applications (treating the same as representation) have been carefully considered by the Competent Authority and the prayers made therein with regard to (i) to constitute a Committee of Technical Officers with the representation of the applicants for cadre restructuring, amendment of RRs by separating the post of Electrician-cum-Plumber (ii) fixing the duty hours of the



applicants and pay overtime allowances for taking duties beyond duty hours (iii) creating post of helper / khallasi in each school to help ECPs while performing duties, have been rejected being devoid of merit but subject to observations made herein above.

With these observations the order dated 17.02.2026 passed by the Hon'ble CAT Principal Bench, New Delhi in OA No. 44/2025 has been duly complied with.

This issues with the approval of the competent authority.
